The field currently needs mowing once a week at least. Karl can show how to run the mowers and where to mow. This Saturday needs a little cleanup for discovery day.

Thanks to all that donated to the additional runway costs as the amount is very close to being completely covered. This is to defray the additional cost increase for the repairs this year. Donations are still being accepted by Karl at this time if anyone wishes to contribute that has not yet.

Runway project – The cracks are repaired now; resurfacing will begin about beginning to mid-August. They are waiting for things to dry up at the ends so the heavy machinery doesn't tear up the lawn. After the blacktop is set; black dirt and grass seed will need to be raked around the new asphalt from some volunteers. At this time there is a large lip at places that can damage aircraft and propellers until the project is finished. Exercise caution entering or exiting from the sides of the runway in its current condition.

Need to follow up the necessity of the AMA grant since the donations have almost covered the runway costs. We may not need the grant anymore.

Pilot training – 6 students with 4 trainers. Mike Curreri is our newest instructor. Monday evenings at 5pm to dusk.

June 14th at 3:30pm Bill Doyle's wife and children will be at the field to spread his ashes on the field as a memorial.
