You will get a certificate upon completion. Karl and Mike Wentworth went through the test already and said its multiple choice, not very complicated, read the paragraph and answer the questions after reading the section. Broken up into multiple sections. Go to AMA website and search "trust safety test". When completed you are registered on the FAA registry. There is no end date that it has to be completed by at this time, but it was heard that we have two years to complete the test. Club position is it is your responsibility to compete test and FAA registration, we will not be policing it.

One trustee position was open and Chris Peters volunteered to fill the spot. Elections are in January for all club officer positions. People should express interest and candidates will be listed in the November newsletter.
