### Old Business

Pilot training – Two students currently: Nathan and Frank. Two students were signed off this year: Chris and Jim. Monday evening training is suspended until next year due to shorter amount of daylight. Training can be performed on Saturdays and Sundays during the day if scheduled with instructors.

Air show report – Thanks to everyone that helped setup, teardown, and work the event. Next year's recommendations are to have more signage, a schedule of events posted by the kitchen/pavilion, and more public relations before the event. Some attendants we asked how they knew about the event said it was the signs by the road, some saw it in the paper, and on internet or flyers. All methods of notification seemed to work equally. One attendant who specialized in marketing said we should have a greater internet presence and or community calendars. Some areas she listed were library, radio, TV community calendars and get the date set a few months in advance so we can get listed earlier on the current event lists.

EAA breakfast – Plane parking went well with 5 members to assist in the duties. The EAA president thanked us personally for helping with their event through a note and email. It was a good day and members that would like to see full scale aircraft up close should attend one of the sessions next year in the spring or fall.

Swap meet – went well good amount of people buying and selling aircraft.

Fall float fly – reported as best float fly yet with lots of members and a fair share of spectators as well. It was recommended to bring the frequency control board next year as there was a radio conflict at the event.

## **New Business**
